# **Finding a Faculty Mentor:**

- I must identify a **UBRP mentor** with which to work this summer and they must sign a Commitment Form to finalize my acceptance into the program. The Commitment form must be submitted via email to <a href="mailto:cubeta@arizona.edu">cubeta@arizona.edu</a> by **Friday, April 5, 2024, at 5:00pm.**
- If I currently do not have a research mentor and do not have a class/work conflict, I will attend at least one **Conversations with Faculty meeting** (see the *Events* section of the UBRP website at ubrp.arizona.edu).

### **Get Hired and Become an Official, Paid Researcher:**

• I will complete all necessary steps for the **UBRP hiring process**, including completing forms and providing proper documentation, **and submit my timesheets through UAccess Employee** in a timely manner. (Employment information will be forthcoming by e-mail.)

### **Learn By Doing: Scientific Research and More:**

- I will attend **UBRP Orientation**, to be held in person on campus on **Monday**, **May 13**, **2024 from 8:00am to 5:00pm in the ENR2 Building**, **Room S107**.
- I will **conduct research** with my UBRP mentor on a full-time basis this summer for 35 hours per week, for a minimum of 12 weeks (a total of 420 hours) between May 14 and August 25, 2024.
- I will participate in UBRP's weekly **Wednesday Meetings** held every Wednesday afternoon on campus from 3:30pm 5:00pm, May 22 through August 7 (except June 19; there will not be a meeting on Juneteenth).
- I will present a poster at the **36<sup>th</sup> Annual UBRP Conference**, which is scheduled to be held on campus on Saturday, January 25, 2025. I will present a poster at subsequent UBRP Conferences each January if I participate in UBRP in following summers/academic years.
- If I am interested in continuing with UBRP during the 2024-25 academic year, I will submit a **Continuation Request** (details forthcoming in July 2024).
- I will submit "Telling My Story" items and program evaluations of my UBRP experience as directed.
